Course Description

Student Expectations

- Students are expected to have all required classroom materials.
- Students are expected to be kind and respectful to Ms. Pedone, other students, and the classroom environment.

- Students are expected to participate in class to the best of their ability, including completing reading and writing assignments, and other classroom activities.
- Students are expected to communicate with Ms. Pedone if an issue arises that prevents them from completing classwork or classroom expectations.

Teacher Expectations

- Ms. Pedone is expected to create a positive and inclusive classroom environment.
- Ms. Pedone is expected to help each student achieve success to the best of her ability.
- Ms. Pedone is expected to grade all assignments fairly and accurately.
- Ms. Pedone is expected to work with all students to help them succeed to the best of her ability, no matter the issue.
- Ms. Pedone is expected to take all student needs into consideration when planning assignments, classroom activities and exams.

Gradebook

- 10% - Participation
 - 5 points/week (one point per day)
 - Points are lost due to: unexcused absences, unexcused tardies, and by not meeting classroom expectations
- 15% - Notebook Checks
 - Will be graded on Friday of each week
 - Warm-Ups, quick writes, etc.
- 40% - Assignments
- 35% - Tests and Quizzes

Make-Up Work

- Students who were absent are responsible for checking the “Absent Work” board for any work they missed while they were gone.
- **Students will have one week from the absence to turn in any missing work.**
- If any student feels as though they need more time to make up classwork, it must be arranged with Ms. Pedone as soon as possible.

Late Work Policy

- Late work is accepted one week after assigned with a grade deduction of one letter grade per week missing.

Classroom Procedure

- Students are responsible for checking the agenda each class and getting out the appropriate materials.
- Every class will begin with a 5 to 10 minute writing exercise, these exercises will be graded on Friday of each week. **Be sure to keep them all in your notebook or you will not receive points for them.**

Bathroom Policy

- Students are allowed to go to the bathroom once per class, and may not be gone more than 5-10 minutes.
 - If bathroom visits become a problem, I will restrict the amount of passes you are allowed.
 - If it is an emergency, let me know and be sure to return promptly if possible.

Electronics Policy
